NACS Chimney Sweep Training Course Outline

- Course Aim:** This course is aimed at both novice and experienced sweeps. It will provide delegates with knowledge and practical experience, which will enable them to confidently work as a Chimney Sweep and trade as a NACS Member.
- Course Duration:** 5 days in total (four days training at the centre, the fifth day of training and assessment will be in the area where you reside with an Area Assessment Inspector).
- Course Times:** Day 1 - 4: **8.45am on site for 9.00am Start – Finish 5.00pm to 5.30pm**
- Entry Requirement:** No chimney sweeping experience is necessary. All candidates must demonstrate a good basic understanding of literacy, numeracy and reading skills i.e. be able to complete the training certificate of chimney sweeping and warning notices etc. prior to assessment. All candidates must have a copy of the current Building Regulation Document J, or Scottish Building Regulations (SBR)
- Tasks Include:** There are practical workshop assessments i.e. sweeping of chimneys and PPE must be worn at all times. In addition, there is a written assessment paper that all candidates must complete. Candidates are required to inspect and clean 16 chimneys in our workshop

- Flues & Ventilation/ How Chimneys Work/Smoke Testing

 - Identification & use of Chimney Pots/Chimney Cows/ Flue Terminals
 - Building Regulations and British Standards

Once qualified you will be able to trade as a NACS Member and have the confidence to start working as a Chimney Sweep.

How to book your course – Via our web-shop or email invoice

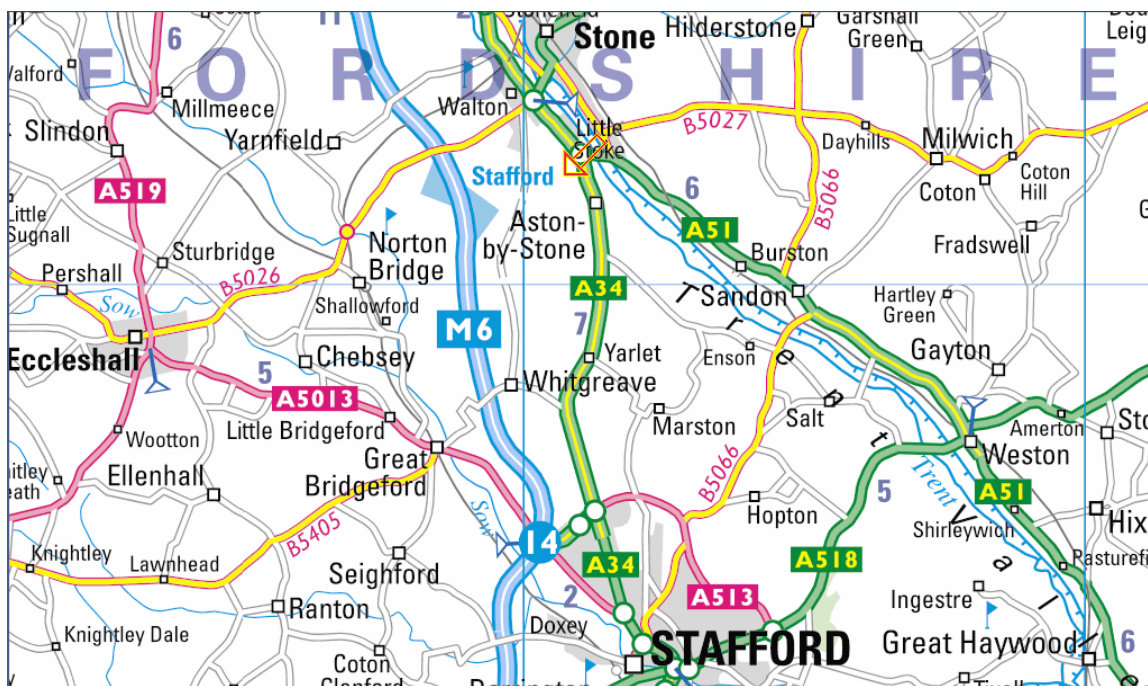

Leave M6 at Junction 14 and turn right onto A34 following signs to Stone. Staying on the A34, pass through two roundabouts and continue towards Stone for approx 5 miles. From North

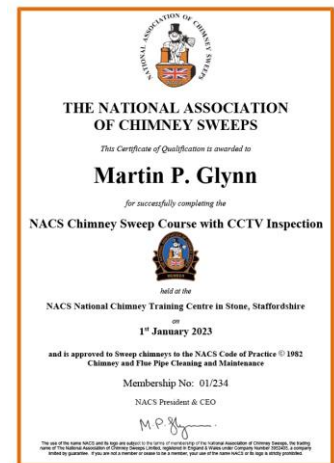
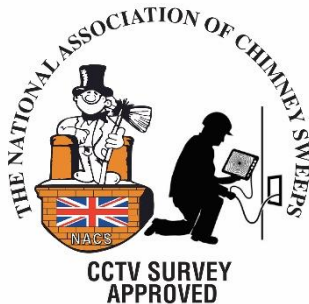
About NACS

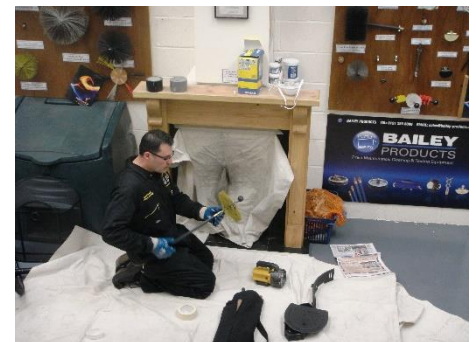
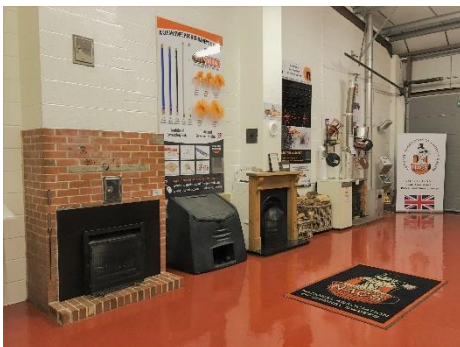
